- Wildlife Captive
- Wildlife Non-Captive
- Travel Nature
- Great Plains Nature

You are invited to submit up to **6 entries** (prints). You may enter all your images in the same category or spread them out. Computer generated or enhanced images must be labeled as such. If there is wildlife in the photo you need to enter it in one of two **Wildlife categories: Captive or Non-Captive** (Wildlife includes all non-domestic, living animals). All photos in the nature categories must portray plant life, geological, meteorological or scenic subjects. **Travel Nature** includes nature subjects from around the world. **Great Plains Nature** photos are for nature subjects within the Great Plains. Kansas nature photos will be placed in this category. Photos depicting man-made objects **prominently** will be disqualified.
