All photos in the nature categories must portray plant life, geological, meteorological or scenic subjects. Travel Nature includes nature subjects from around the world. Great Plains Nature photos are for nature subjects within the Great Plains. Kansas nature photos will be placed in this category. Photos depicting man-made objects prominently will be disqualified.
